### Group Training Activity in Zalec

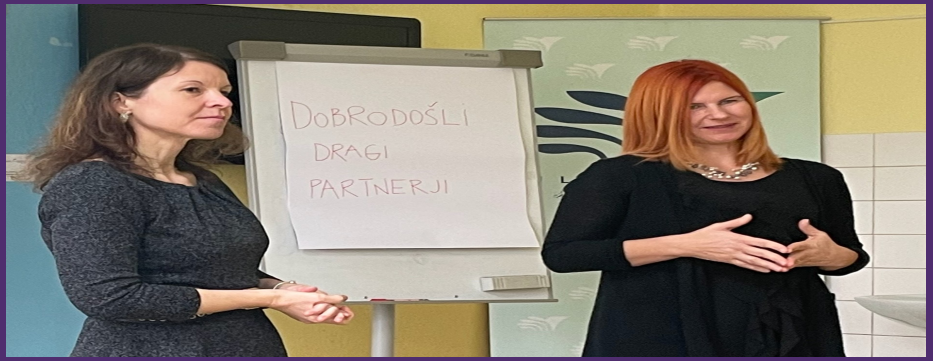
